### **Board of Directors/Leadership Council/Advisory Council**

Expectations:

- Board of Directors are expected to commit and carry out the mission and goals of United Cerebral Palsy of Nebraska by contributing personal expertise, talent, and time.
- Board of Directors are elected for a term of 5 years and may serve consecutive terms.
- Four meetings are scheduled each year. Members are encouraged to attend all meetings but a minimum attendance of 75% is expected. Meetings are in-person; however, virtual attendance is available for members outside of Omaha and for special circumstances.
- Board of Directors are expected to attend fundraising and program events when possible. Minimum attendance expected is 50% of fundraising events.
- Board of Directors are expected to contribute a minimum of \$2,500 annually, either as a personal financial contribution, secured sponsorship, or in-kind contribution. A "Give or Get" philosophy.

This annual golf tournament raises funds to support our programs and services. It's an opportunity to create awareness and build community support for our mission.

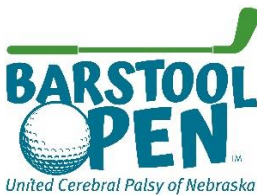
### Committee Member Responsibilities:
